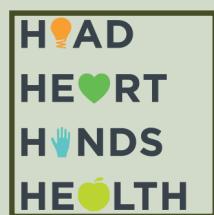

What is 4-H?

4-H is the youth development program for the Cooperative Extension Service. It focuses on the needs, concerns, and interests of young people. Its aim is to help youth gain a positive self-concept, rational social behavior, knowledge and problem-solving capabilities.

Through planned individual projects, meetings, group activities and participation in different events, members develop new skills, learn cooperation, develop leadership abilities, improve their citizenship and have fun.

4-H focuses on the LEARN-BY-DOING model, participation is key.

Young people from all ethnic or cultural groups, ages 8-18 are eligible to join 4-H.
